- We are representing Jesus as the body
- The body of Jesus is divine and we should manifest more than ever
- We have been joined and knitted together
- Gossip needs to stop as God is showing to the world

**1 Corinthians 12:12-13, 18 BSB**

*The body is a unit, though it is composed of many parts. And although its parts are many, they all form one body. So it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free, and we were all given one Spirit to drink. But in fact, God has arranged the members of the body, every one of them, according to His design*

- Do not tamper with the order of God
- The body is not an audience, we are part of the body
- It is not an option for us
- Jesus will always bring us back to the community
- There is a new covenant with one another and Jesus

**John 17:21 NLT**

*I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me.*

- Every part of the body is functional and has a purpose
- Everywhere the body goes there should be a manifestation
- We should see each other differently

**Acts 2:38-42 The Message**

*Peter said, “Change your life. Turn to God and be baptized, each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ, so your sins are forgiven. Receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is targeted to you and your children, but also to all who are far away—whomever, in fact, our Master God invites.” He went on in this vein for a long time, urging them over and over, “Get out while you can; get out of this sick and stupid culture!” That day about three thousand took him at his word, were baptized and were signed up. They committed themselves to the teaching of the apostles, the life together, the common meal, and the prayers.*

- We should get out of this stupid culture
- The fellowship of the believers
- They devoted themselves – it speaks about loyalty
- It is not about what you like to do
- Each person compliments the body
- There is a time coming when signs and wonders will take place and God is going to use the body amazingly
- The breaking of bread was instituted by Jesus Himself. It is an action

### **1 Corinthians 10:16-17 AMP**

*Is the cup of blessing which we bless [at the Lord's Supper] not a sharing in the blood of Christ? [Indeed it is.] Is the bread which we break not a sharing in the body of Christ? [Indeed it is.] Since there is one bread, we [believers] who are many are [united into] one body; for we all partake of the one bread [which represents the body of Christ].*

- You are the body bringing the glory of God to the earth
- The first believers were connected to one another they were devoted to prayer

### **Acts 4:32 BSB**

*The multitude of believers was one in heart and soul. No one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they shared everything they owned.*

- They understood that each person was a member of the body of Jesus Christ
- There was something different in them
- We need to let go of our selfishness
- It is not church activities, it is body activities
- The communion is a symbolism of the connectivity of the body
- There is a heavenly audience that is watching us Jesus is present
- The communion is a reaffirmation of what Jesus did for us and gives us the opportunity to trade in
- Do not struggle with your sin – trade it in
- The blood cleanses us
- Trade in self-consciousness for God-consciousness
- Before you go to sleep there need to be a consciousness about Him
