The SIN Issue.....

- Separation from God's presence -Ephesians 2:11-13

Therefore, remember that previously you, the Gentiles in the flesh, who are called "Uncircumcision" by the so-called "Circumcision" which is performed in the flesh by human hands—remember that you were at that time separate from Christ, [a]excluded from [b]the people of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of the promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who previously were far away [c]have been brought near [d]by the blood of Christ

- Eternal Death - Rom 3:20

For the wages of sin is death, but the gracious gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.



A Prophecy of the Suffering & Crucifixion of JESUS



V 2 No heavenly glory . Human man with no sin

V3 Was despised and forsaken (by men & His Father)

V4 He bore our griefs, carried our sorrows

V5 Pierced for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities. Scourging we are healed

V6 All have sinned, gone astray

V7 He was oppressed and afflicted

V10 Gave himself as a guilt offering



JESUS Informed His Disciples about his Crucifixion, Resurrection & Accension

John 12: 27-33 16:16

V27,28 The Fathers Purpose

V30 For your sake

V32 Be lifted- be Crucified

16 V6 Won't see him for much longer

V28 From the Father to the world and back to the father

LAST SUPPER - Matt 26:26-28

V26 Bread – The body of Jesus

V28 Blood – New covenant – the forgiveness of sin



What did JESUS “experience” during His Suffering & Crucifixion

Read John 19:16-30

Physically	Mentally	Spiritually
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 39 lashes with a whip• Carried his cross• Beard pulled out• Crown of thorns• Beaten up• Nailed on cross• Crucified – crucifixion agony	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rejected by the Jews• Disciples not close when he was crucified• Alone• Spat on, mocked with purple robe• Made fun of - sign on cross (“King of the Jews”)• Despised	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• “My God, my God why have you forsaken me” Matt 27• Sacrificial Lamb - Carried the sins of the world• Bore our griefs & sorrows• Being made a curse for us (Gal 3:13)



“It Is Finished” - JESUS - the Perfect Sacrifice for SIN.....

Heb 10:19-20

Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, through His flesh.....

Legally the debt owned by man to his Creator on account of Adam’s sin is finally and forever dealt with – THE BLOOD

A sacrifice for

- Eternal Redemption (Heb 9:12-15)
- Fully cleansing our conscience (Heb 9:14)
- Once and for all (Heb 10-14)
- Sacrifice that made the impossible possible.
No need for sacrifices for atonement (Heb 10:4)
- He experience rejection, mockery, shame



After 3 days - An Empty Tomb.....

- **Jesus appeared 12 times to different groups sizes ranging from just 1 person 500 people**
- The resurrection guarantees us that we will not remain dead but we too will be resurrected 1 Thess 4:15
- The resurrection of Christ gives us an assurance that our
 - salvation is an accomplished fact Rom 10:9
- The resurrection proves the deity of Christ Rom 1:4 (Father raised him from the dead)
- We are resurrected into a new life with Christ
Rom 6:4-9

Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too may walk in newness of life. For if we have become [a]united with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be [b]in the likeness of His resurrection, knowing this, that our old [c]self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be [d]done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; for the one who has died is [e]freed from sin. Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, [f]is never to die again; death no longer is master over Him.
